

RE Mastery

In RE we use the terms 'Paddling, Snorkelling and Diving,' to illustrate the levels of mastery required when approaching a topic.

For example when looking at The Parables in KS 1, children will be:



Paddling – If they can recall / retell one of the stories e.g. The Parable of Good Samaritan



Snorkelling – If they can demonstrate some understanding of the story or the important message behind it e.g. What love means in the story / who the good neighbour was and why.



Diving – If they can apply this knowledge to how Christians might apply this to their lives.

Possibly evaluate – how difficult would this be. Create - their own parable
