Thoughtful

Jesus is thoughtful about the needs of his disciples as well as the large crowd listening to Him during the feeding of the 5000 - **Matthew 14:13-21**.

He spends time being thoughtful in the garden of Gethsemane. **Luke 22:39-46**

He is thoughtful and considers his mother, even when He is on the cross. **John 19: 26-27**

Honesty

Zacchaeus turned from a dishonest man to an honest man in **Luke 19: 1-10**

The woman was honest when Jesus asked ' Who touched my robe?' **Mark 5:30**

Fair

Jesus was angry at the way the temple had been turned into a marketplace - **Matthew 21:12-13**

Throughout his whole life, Jesus upheld the rights of the sick and the weak both in his stories and his miracles e.g. The Good Samaritan and the healing of the ten lepers.

Kindness – We have shared the story of The Paralysed Man to illustrate this value.
