English

This half term we will be using a range of texts...

To develop our writing skills and produce....

- ★ A narrative
- ★ A persuasive text
- ★ An information text.

We are reading...



We will be immersing ourselves in a wide range of texts using VIPERS with reading comprehension tasks.

Reading is a crucial skill, so we will be promoting a love for reading through our class texts.

Maths

We will be learning about:

- ★ Mass and Capacity – measuring and comparing equivalent capacities and volumes ml and l.
- ★ Money – add and subtract amounts of money to give change, using both £ and p in practical contexts.
- ★ Time - tell and write the time from an analogue clock, estimate and read time with increasing accuracy to the nearest minute and compare durations of an event.

Art

In art we will be linking to our science topic (plants) and learning

- ★ How to use colour to express mood.
- ★ A range of ways to apply paint; dotting, scratching and splashing.
- ★ How to print using polystyrene tiles.

Science

In science, we will begin our Plants topic that looks at:

The functions of different parts of flowering plants.

The requirements of plants for life and growth.

How water is transported within plants.

The part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants.



Geography

We will be working on our Understanding of the physical and human geographical features of a region in North America.

- ★ The same and meanings of Sikh symbols.

Music

In music, children will be having whole-class recorder tuition. We will be working on...

understanding the variety of sounds the recorder can produce.

Performing simple rhythmic and musical parts.

Playing more than one part at the same time to create texture.

PSHE

Our topic is Relationships; we will be thinking about Family roles and responsibilities

- ★ Friendship and negotiation
- ★ Keeping safe online and who to go to for help
- ★ Being a global citizen and being aware of how my choices affect others.

Computing/French



In computing this term we are looking at **creating media**. We will be Planning and creating our own video trailers using iPads.

FRENCH – In a French Classroom:

In this unit, classroom commands and the concept of noun gender will be introduced. The children will learn to respond and give simple instructions, the key vocabulary for items commonly found in school and begin to build simple sentences using constructions and simple connectives.

PE

In PE, this term we will be doing Athletics and Tennis.

Through this we will explore how we can use our bodies to run and jump as far as possible. Pupils will work on hitting the ball into space on their opponent's side of the court and recovering immediately to be ready to return the ball.
