

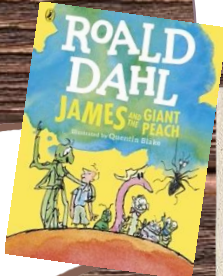
# Spring Two in Year 3



## English

This half term we will be using a range of texts...

**We are reading...**



- Dragonology
- The Boy who Grew Dragons
- James and the Giant Peach

To develop our writing skills and produce...

- A narrative.
- An explanation text.
- Newspaper Report

We will be immersing ourselves in a wide range of texts using VIPERS with reading comprehension tasks.

Reading is a crucial skill, so we will be promoting a love for reading through our Class texts.

## Maths

We will be learning about:

- Length and Perimeter – equivalent lengths mm/cm and cm/m, comparing lengths and calculating perimeter
- Fractions – recognise, find and write fractions and show, using diagrams. Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator within one whole compare and order unit fractions, and fractions with the same denominators.
- Mass and Capacity - measuring and comparing equivalent capacities and volumes ml and l.

## D&T

In D&T we will be looking at seasonal food.

We will be expanding our understanding of what seasonal means and how some foods grow at particular times of the year.

We will be tasting and making our own Vegetable tart that uses foods that are in season.

## Science

In science, we will be continuing our 'Animals including Humans' Topic and will be planning and carrying out an investigation.

We will begin our **Plants** topic that looks at: The functions of different parts of flowering plants. The requirements of plants for life and growth How water is transported within plants. The part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants.



## History

In history we will be looking at the Bronze Age: What is the secret of the standing stones?

We will be...:

- Learning about the key changes that occurred in Britain towards the end of the Neolithic period of the Stone Age and the progress these brought about in society.
- Reflecting upon the reasons why Bronze Age people may have constructed the large number of stone monuments that still exist in many parts of the country.

## RE

What kind of world did Jesus want?

In this topic we will be...

- Thinking about the world we live in today.
- Looking at what The Bible tells us about the world that Jesus wanted.
- Considering what Christians in today's world and our local community do to make the world more how Jesus wanted it

## Computing

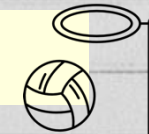
Computing systems and networks:
