



## **Pupil Governor Minutes 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2022**

- 1) Our fundraising for Children in Need was a huge success. We have raised approximately £450.

Action- Pupil Governors to thank their class.

- 2) At the last meeting Pupil Governors discussed possible rewards for the winning house. It was decided that a 'house party' or a 'non-school uniform day' would be preferable for this half term. Pupil Governors held a vote and the reward for this term will be a 'House Party'.

Action- Inform school community that this term's reward is a 'House Party'. Mrs Spicer to arrange a date and time for this.

- 3) Safeguarding. Where do I feel safe survey? Mrs Spicer has made a map of the school where children will be asked to plot where they feel safe. This will be colour coded. Children will place a coloured dot on the map indicating where they do/do not feel safe.

RED- I do not feel safe here

ORANGE- I sometimes feel safe here.

GREEN- I feel safe here.

These maps will be given to class teachers next week for every child to fill out. KS1 and Reception will need an alternative map with photos on which is suitable for their age range.

Action- Upper KS2 Pupil Governors to take photos for the map.

Action- Mrs Spicer to email staff on behalf of the Pupil Governors asking them to ensure every child completes this survey. In the spring term Pupil Governors will collect the information and take action where necessary.
