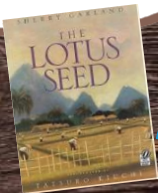

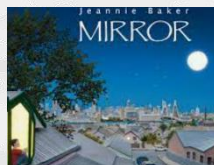
The Book With No Pictures

Maths

Statistics – drawing and interpreting tally charts and pictograms

- We will be studying the artist William Morris
- We will look at prints in nature. We will practise creating repeating patterns using observational drawings. We will explore printing and use Photography to practise using angles for effect.



Geography

How does the location of Kampong Ayer compare with where I live?

We will make comparisons between our lives and those of people in a small diverse community in the country of Brunei on the tropical island of Borneo, in southeast Asia. We will learn the similarities and differences that exist between our own local area and Kampong Ayer, both in ways of life and of the geographical features.

World Religion - Islam

We will learn why Eid is important to Muslims.

We will learn that Eid-ul-Adha is a Muslim festival remembering sacrifice and for saying Thank You and that Eid remembers the story of Ibrahim and Isma'il in The Qur'an. We will look at how Muslims celebrate Eid-ul-Adha.

Music

African Music

We will be making music with djembe drums to practice 'Call and Response.'

- 'Call and Response' enables everyone in communities to participate in music making.
- We will also be learning some African songs:

'Funga Alafia' - a welcoming song

'Thula Baba; - a Zulu lullaby

'Che Che Kule' - a call and response song from Ghana

'Shosholoza' - a song of encouragement to keep going forwards.

Ball skills (2):
