English

During the course of this term the Children will be using these texts to create a variety of pieces.

When reading The London Eye Mystery the Children will be creating a mystery narrative using the story as a basis.

Using Shakespeare, the children will be creating a retelling a Classic narrative.

We are reading...



The children will be reading:

The London Eye Mystery by Siobhan David and Macbeth by William Shakespeare

As our class readers this term the children will be reading:

Wonder by R.J. Palacio and Can You See Me? by Libby Scott and Rebecca Westcott.

These texts include a complex narrator and are wonderful for transition to secondary school.

Maths

Over the course of this term we will be covering:

Number: Ratio

Geometry: Properties of Shape Consolidation, investigations and preparation for KS3.



D&T

During the course of this term the children will be looking at:

Food and how it is used to celebrate culture and seasonality. This unit also links with PSHE and Science discussing which foods are important in our diets as well as religion and how food is used in celebration.



Science

Over the course of this term the children will be looking at:

STOBOROUGH'S GOT SCIENCE

This unit allows our children to explore our school value of 'curiosity' in action. Pupils research and carry out an investigation which they then present to their peers.



History

This half term History topic question is: Why did Britain once rule the largest empire the world has ever seen?

The children will be focusing on the rise and decline of the British Empire and what contributed to this as well as the Falklands War.



RE

The children's RE unit this term covers the whole of Summer term and focuses on how Art can represent many different religious aspects. This unit is called Art in Heaven and focuses around spiritual places, places of worship and pilgrimage. It also explores concepts such as Creation.



Music

Samba Music- During this unit the children will be experiencing and analysing different rhythmic patterns from music around the world. Using this as a model, children will create their own Samba pieces.



PSHE

Changing me- During this unit the children will be learning about:

- being aware of my own self-image,
- develop my own self-esteem,
- how girls' and boys' bodies change during puberty,
- describe how a baby develops from conception relationships and the independence of becoming a teenager.

Computing/French

Online Safety- identifying possible dangers online and ways to stay safe. Create an animation about digital safety. Learning to use an online community safely. Understand not everything online is true or correct and how to check for validity.

FRENCH: Visiting a town in France- Learning directional, transport and town vocabulary together with prepositional phrases, the children describe their journey to school, plan a trip to France and become tourist guides, giving reasoned opinions on which places in town to visit; finally, the children create a tourist leaflet, in French, for their own local area.
