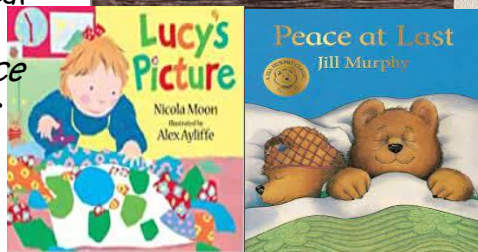


Summer Two in Year 1

We are reading...

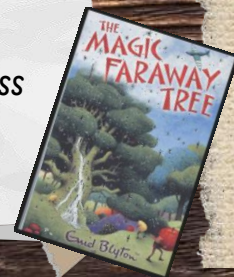


We will also be keeping diaries to compare our lives now to those of children during World War 1.

Reading

We will continue to build our phonics knowledge and skills through our Read Write Inc. programme as well as practise our comprehension and inference skills when we share our high quality class stories or read 1:1 with a grown up.



Maths

We extend our learning of place value up to 100 and begin to explore multiplication and division. We will also begin to investigate telling the time and handling money.

Science

We will investigate our senses and the ways in which we use them to navigate and adapt to the world around us.

D&T

Fruit Salad

In keeping with our science topic about our senses, we will be exploring different tastes and textures of fruit. We will then plan and create a fruit salad for our friends.



History

First World War

We will be learning about the First World War.

Our investigations will include learning about the challenges of communication during the war, the important part that animals played and the ways that adults and children had to adapt to a Changing world.

RE

World Religion - Judaism

We continue our exploration of other religions, focusing on Judaism. We will enjoy a visit from Lynda at Living Judaism to help aid our understanding of the festivals and traditions of this religion.

Music

Rhythms from around the world
We will be experiencing different rhythms used in music from: Spain, Scotland, Ukraine, Greece.

We will listen to musical examples, dance to the music and use percussion.

Changes

This term, our topic looks at the changes in us since being a baby, the differences between female and male bodies (correct terminology), ways to cope with change and understanding the link between growing and learning.

Introduction to Data Handling

We will be learning:
