


Year Group: 3	Term: Autumn 2	Topic: Adjectives of colour, size and shape (5 lessons)

Must Have Knowledge:

- To know that a cognate is a word that is the same in both French and English e.g. un triangle.
- To know the adjectives of size are positioned in front of the noun in French e.g. un grand cercle.
- To know that adjectives of colour are positioned after the noun in French e.g. un cercle bleu.

Key Vocabulary:




Skills:
