Must have knowledge:

- To know how search engines work.

Key Vocabulary:

Search Engine: A way for a user to search the internet's database of information.

WWW: The acronym used to express the 'World Wide Web'. It is found at the beginning of website addresses

Website: A series of web pages and other content, which can be discovered and read through an internet browser, that all belong to a single domain name. For example, Google.

Online: When a person is accessing the internet through an electronic device.

Key skills

- Developing searching skills to help find relevant information on the internet.
- Learning how to use search engines effectively to find information, focussing on keyword searches and evaluating search returns.
- Recognising that information on the Internet might not be true or correct and learning ways of checking validity
