

Year 5: What does it mean if **God** is loving and holy?

Prior learning:

To know Christians believe:

- in God, and that they find out about God in the Bible.
- God is loving, kind, fair and forgiving, and also Lord and King and that some stories show these Christian beliefs.
- To know that Christians worship God and try to live in ways that please him.

Key Concept: INCARNATION

What should we know?

Christians believe:

- God is omnipotent, omniscient and eternal.
- God is both holy and loving.
- They have to balance ideas of God being angered by sin and injustice but also loving, forgiving, and full of grace.
- Not all Christians agree with what God is like, but that try to follow his path, as they see it in the Bible.

- ✓ **Evaluate** how biblical ideas and teachings about God as holy and loving might make a difference in the world today, developing insights of my own.
