To know that Christians see Holy Week as the culmination of Jesus' earthly life, leading to his death and resurrection.

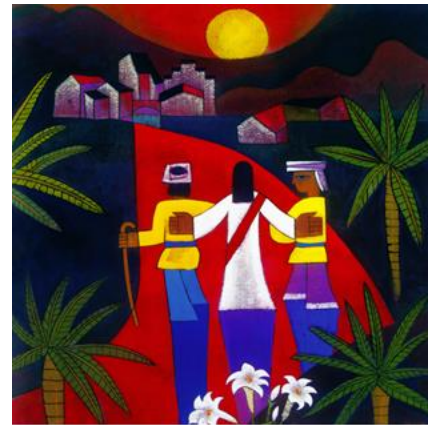
To know that Christians remember and celebrate Jesus' last week, death and resurrection.

### Key Concept: Salvation

### What should we know?

- To know that Christians read the 'big story' of the Bible as pointing out the need for God to save people.
- To know that the New Testament says that Jesus' death was somehow 'for us'.
- To know that Christians believe that Jesus calls them to sacrifice their own needs to the needs of others.



## What should we be able to do?

- To make connections between the Christian belief in Jesus' death as a sacrifice and how Christians celebrate Holy Communion.
- To describe the ways that Christians interpret Jesus' death in a variety of ways, e.g. as a sacrifice for sin, leading from darkness to light.
