-To know that the New Testament says that Jesus' death was somehow 'for us'.

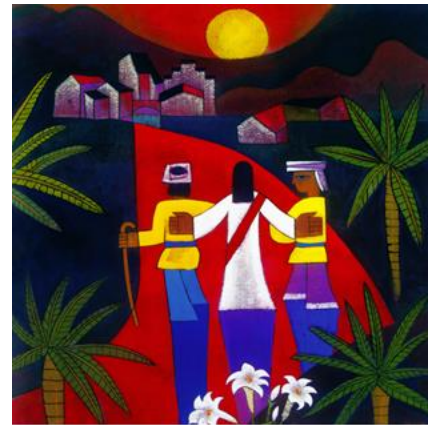

#### Key Concept: Salvation

#### What should we know?

- To know that belief in Jesus' resurrection confirms to Christians that Jesus is the incarnate Son of God, but also that death is not the end.
- This belief gives Christians hope for life with God, starting now and continuing in a new life (heaven).



### What should we be able to do?

- Suggest meanings for the resurrection accounts, and compare their ideas with ways in which Christians interpret these texts.
- Make clear connections between Christian belief in the Resurrection and how Christians worship on Good Friday.
- Explain why some people find belief in the resurrection makes sense and inspires them.
