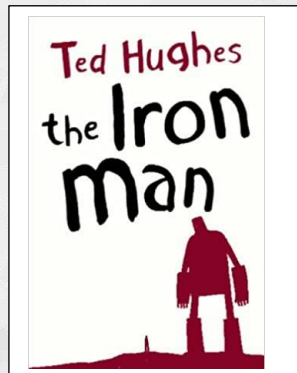
English

Place Value

Represent numbers to 1000 + 10000

Where does all that food go?

Children will learn:

That digestion is the process of breaking down food into other substances that our bodies can use.

About the functions of the parts of the digestive system: mouth to chew the food; esophagus to transport the food; stomach to break food down; intestines to absorb nutrients and water.

That humans have different types of teeth: incisors for slicing, canines for tearing and molars and premolars for grinding.

Art

Megacities

The children will explore a variety of artists and a range of art techniques and mediums, which will contribute to them creating a final cityscape piece of artwork.

They will:

- Experiment with different grades of pencil – show light and dark areas as well as well as colour using paint, pastels and collage.
- Observational drawing of human made buildings with an awareness of third dimension.
- Learn about the artists - Georgia O'Keefe, Stephen Wiltshire, James Rizzi and Charles Fazzino is and how they all create their own unique cityscapes.

Explore some of the economic and social reasons why population of cities increase. Compare and contrast the benefits and problems that can arise in urban areas as a result of housing people at such high densities

French

French-Portraits

Describe someone's appearance, including eye and hair colour and characteristics such as how happy or serious they are. This unit teaches the position of adjectives in a sentence and how the adjective changes to 'agree' with the noun it describes (masculine, feminine, singular, plural).
