



Pupil Governor Minutes

Friday 24th October 2025

1) Welcome

Mrs White welcomed the Pupil Governors and began the meeting by talking about **Children in Need**. She asked the Pupil Governors what they remembered from previous years and introduced this year's theme: **“Challenge 25.”**

2) Children in Need – Challenge 25

The group discussed how we could incorporate the “Challenge 25” theme into activities for the week.

- **Sophie** suggested linking it to the five school days in the week.
- **Joe** suggested using the **track on the playground**.

Together, the group decided that everyone could **walk, run, or move around the track five times each day** throughout the week - reaching a total of **25 laps** by the end of the week.

3) World Diabetes Day - Tuesday 14th November

Mrs White shared that it will also be **World Diabetes Day** on 14th November, and that some pupils in school are passionate about raising awareness and funds for diabetes charities.

The group agreed that:

- A **cake sale** (Joe's previous idea) would be a good way to raise money.
- The cake sale could be held at the end of the school day, and the money raised would be split between Children in Need and a diabetes charity.

4) Non-Uniform Day

The group also agreed that a **non-uniform day** is a fun way to raise money.

To link with World Diabetes Day, the chosen colour will be **blue**, and the slogan will be:



“Blue to suit you!”

Everyone will be encouraged to wear something blue.

5) Track Challenge (ways to Move)

The group thought about how people don't just have to walk or run around the track. **Nico** and **Joe** mentioned that in previous years, music and motivational signs helped make the challenge fun and energetic.

The Pupil Governors suggested different ways to move around the track:

- **Kitty:** Skipping
- **Lily:** Walking
- **Charlie:** Hopping
- **Joe:** Crab walking
- **Lucy:** Walking backwards
- **Nico:** Dance moves

Everyone agreed these would make the challenge more exciting and inclusive.

6) Next Steps

- Governors will share these ideas with their classes and gather feedback.
- Mrs White and Mrs Spicer will help organise posters and letters to share with families about the fundraising events.
